

EMJM in brief...

A high-level integrated & transnational study programme at MA level

Open to all disciplines

Delivered by an international consortium of HEIs from different countries worldwide

Offering high-level scholarships to excellent students worldwide



EMJM principles...

A jointly designed fully integrated curriculum and common implementation (joint admission and selection of students, common services etc.)

Be delivered by a consortium of at least three HEI from three different countries of which at least two must be EU-member states

International outreach to attract and enrol students worldwide (some may benefit from an EMJM scholarship)



EMJM principles...

- Compulsory physical mobility for all enrolled students at least 2 study periods in two countries with a minimum duration of one academic semester (each different from the country of residence of the student)
- Delivery of a joint degree or double/multiple degrees
- At application stage EMJM proposals must present fully developed joint study programmes, ready to run and to be advertised worldwide after their selection



EMJM principles...

Commitment to enrol a certain number of students per project

- ✓ 4 master editions lasting 1 to 2 academic years (60-120 ECTS)
- Start of the 1st edition no later than the academic year following the year of project selection

Geographical balance of students: No more than 10% of total scholarships to students of the same nationality (does not apply to additional scholarships for targeted regions)



EMJM Scholarships

- € 1400 per month
- For up to 24 months
- 60 scholarships guaranteed for EU and Non-EU applicants
- Additional scholarships for targeted regions
- Pro-rata allocation

Total allocation € 2.000.000+ per project



EU contribution to institutional costs

- Unit cost per enrolled student of € 750/month
- Cap of 100 enrolled students
- Additional unit costs for scholarships for targeted regions
- Pro-rata allocation
- Student enrolment must be ensured at all times!

Total allocation € 1.800.000+ per project



What is an Erasmus Mundus Design Measure project?

- EU grant to support institutions in the set-up of a new joint master programme in Europe (and beyond)
- Fixed lump sum contribution of 55.000 Euros (for costs linked to the activities necessary to set up the new joint master programme)
- ✓ One beneficiary mobilising a group of other HEIs
- Independent funding scheme from EMJM (independent calls for proposals)
- Fixed duration of 15 months



Expected outcomes of an EMDM project

The jointly designed master should:

- Offer a fully integrated curriculum delivered by a consortium (involving at least three HEIs from three different countries, of which at least two must be EU Member States)
- Include physical mobility for all recruited students
- Lead to either a Joint degree or double/multiple degrees
- **No obligation** to apply for EMJM project



Application procedure

- EMJM & EMDM applications are submitted to the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA)

Expected deadline medio February 2024 (yearly call-for-applications)
Expected publication of call-for-proposals November 2023
