

## **English Proficiency**

## The knowledge of English may be certified by following documents

- University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations (FCE, CAE): at least B2 level (from 160 score)
- Educational Testing Service (ETS), Princeton, USA: Test of English as a Foreign Language (**TOEFL**) at least B2 level: from 72 points in Internet-Based Test version (iBT) \*Special Home Edition is not accepted
- British Council, Cambridge English Language Assessment IDP IELTS Australia: International English Language Testing System (IELTS) at least B2 level (from 5,5) \*IELTS Indicator is not accepted
- University of Warsaw <u>Language Proficiency Form</u>, signed by student's home institution, confirming at least B2 level
- An official document issued in English by student's home institution encompassing all four components (reading, writing, speaking, listening) and clearly stating student's level of English (at least B2)
- A document certifying graduation from university abroad or in the Republic of Poland provided that the document clearly states the programme was delivered exclusively in English
- <u>International Baccalaureate Diploma</u>, <u>European Baccalaureate Diploma</u> or <u>Polish maturity exam in English language at advanced level</u> ("new maturity diploma") with result of at least 60%
- A document issued abroad recognised to be equivalent with a high school diploma provided that the document clearly states the programme was delivered exclusively in English and that it meets the requirements of Education Authorities in Poland
- Certificate on completion of <u>Foundation Year at the University</u> of <u>Warsaw</u>
- Recommendation of the Centre of Foreign Language Teaching UW issued after participation in the Central Foreign Language Proficiency Examination (CFLPE) register at Kampus e-learning platform
- <u>University Council for the Coordination of Foreign Language Teaching and Language Proficiency Certification</u> at least B2 level
